- Vigil Mass (Missal and Graduale) -  
To - mor - row the wickedness of the earth will be de - STROY - ed;

- Vigil Mass -  
the Savior of the world will REIGN o - VER us.

- Mass at Night -

(Missal) I pro - claim to you good news of GREAT joy: | Today a Savior is BORN (for) us, CHRIST (the) Lord.  
(Graduale) The Lord said unto me: "You ARE (my) Son, | today I HAVE be-GOT-(ten) you."

- Mass at Dawn -

(Missal) Glory to God in the HIGH-est, | and on earth peace to those on WHOM his FA-(vor) rests.  
(Graduale) The Lord is king, he has enrobed himself in majes-(†ty); the Lord has clothed him-SELF (with) strength; |  
he has GIRD-(ed) him-SELF (with) pow'r.

- Mass during the Day (Missal and Graduale) -

A ho-ly day has dawned upon (†us); come you nations and a-DORE (the) Lord. |  
For today a great light has COME up-ON (the) earth.

- **Vigil Mass** -  
 (M & G) Tomorrow the wickedness of the earth will be de - stroyed;  
 - **Mass at Night** -  
 (Missal) I proclaim to you good news of great joy:  
 (Graduale) The Lord said unto me: "You are my Son,  
 - **Mass at Dawn** -  
 (Missal) Glory to God in the highest,  
 (Graduale) The Lord is King, he has enrobed himself in maj - es - ty;  
 - **Mass during the Day** -  
 (M & G) A holy day has dawned upon us; come, you nations, and a - dore the Lord.

- **Vigil Mass** -  
 (M & G) The Savior of the world will reign o - ver us.  
 - **Mass at Night** -  
 (Missal) today a Savior is born for us, Christ the Lord.  
 (Graduale) to - day I have be - got - ten you.  
 - **Mass at Dawn** -  
 (Missal) and on earth, peace to those on whom his fa - vor rests.  
 (Graduale) he has gird - ed him - self with pow'r.  
 - **Mass during the Day** -  
 (M & G) For today a great light has come up - on the earth.
