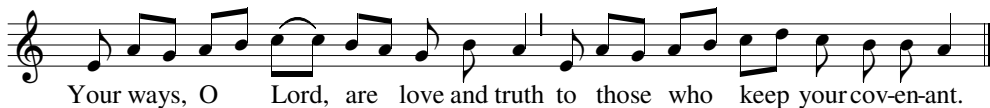

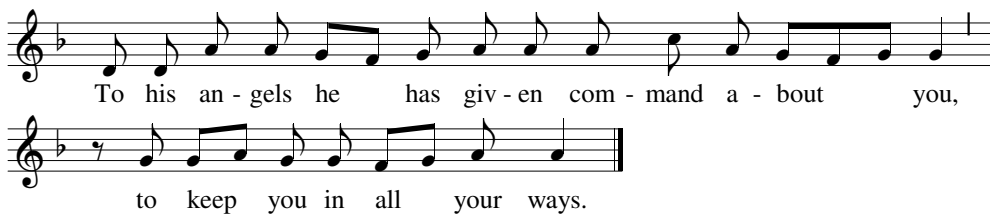

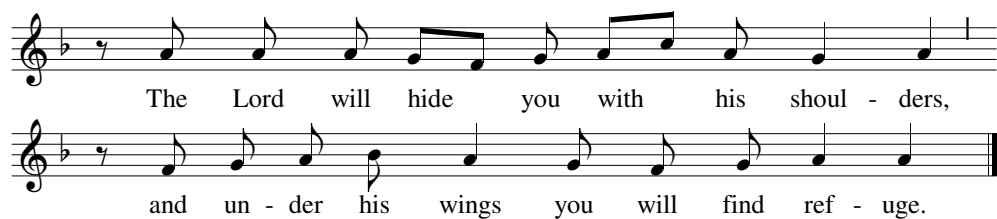
11-g. Tract
