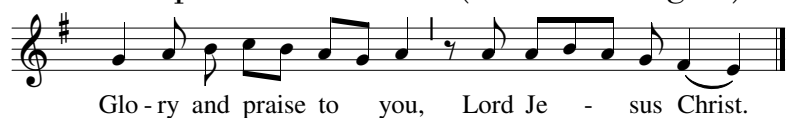


1. a. O Lord, hear my prayer, and let my cry come unto you.

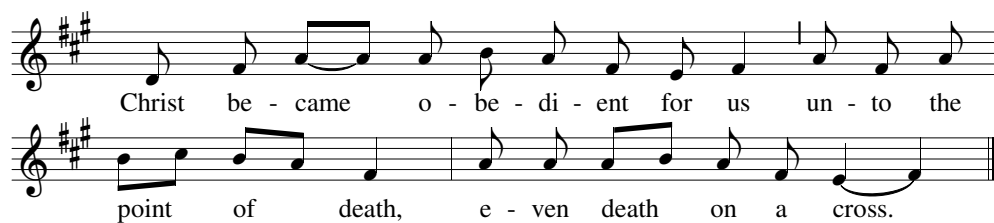

*Intoned by chanter(s), then repeated by ALL.*

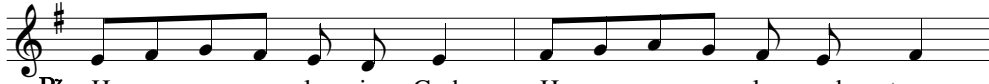


My peo - ple, what have I done to you?
