
13-d. Responsorial Psalm (Year C, ad libitum)

℣ Psalm 104 (103): 1-4, 24-25, 27-30

4. *They look to you to give them food in due time. / When you give it to them, they gath(er) it*; *
when you open your hand, they are *filled with good things*. ℣.
5. a. *If you take away their breath, they perish* * and return to their **dust**.
b.* When you send forth your Spirit, they are **created**, * and you renew the *face of the earth*. ℣.
