


# THE BAPTISM OF THE LORD

## 13-g. Communion


℣. Galatians 3: 27

4. Above the flood the Lord is seated; the Lord reigns for ev - er as King.

2. the voice of the Lord, is mighty; The voice of the Lord is ma - jestic. ℣.
