


## 227a. Communion (Sunday A)


*℣ Matthew 6: 33*



Seek first the king-dom of God, and the rest will be add-ed un-to you, says the Lord.


*℣ Psalm 37 (36): 1, 3, 16, 18, 19, 23, 27-28, 28-29, 34.*
