## 44-n. Communion (Sunday C)

℣. John 2: 7-8

℣ John 2: 7-11; Psalm 66 (65): 1-6, 8

1. a. *When the master of the feast tasted the water that had become wine,* \*  
He said to the bridegroom: "You have kept the good **wine until now.**"
- b. \* This was the **first sign** \* of what Jesus accomplished *before his disciples.* ℣.
2. a. *Shout with joy unto God, all (the) earth;* \* sing praise to the *glory of (his) Name;*
- b. \* render unto him **glo(rious) praise,** \* say to God: How *tremendous are (your) deeds.* ℣.
3. a. *Let all on earth bow down and praise you;* \* sing praises *unto his Name!*
- b. \* Come and see the **works (of) God,** \* tremendous his deeds among the *children of Adam.* ℣.
4. a. *He has changed the sea into dry land;* \* through the river *they passed (on) foot.*
- b. \* O you peoples, **bless (the) Lord;** \* let the sound of *his praise (re)sound.* ℣.

 2b. render unto him glo - rious praise. Say unto God, "How tremendous are — your deeds!" ℣.  
 3b. Come and see the works of God, his awesome deeds among the chil - dren of Adam. ℣.  
 4b. O you peoples, bless the Lord, let the sound of his praise — re - sound. ℣.
