




℣ Psalm 97 (96): 1, 4, 5-6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 12.




1. The Lord is King, let the earth re-joice; let the many islands be glad.
2. The mountains melt like wax before the Lord, before the Lord of all the earth.




1. His lightnings have shone forth to the world, the earth saw and trembled. *℣*
