


## The Easter Vigil in the Holy Night - Responsorial Psalm After Reading IV

*℣ Psalm 30 (29): 2*




I will praise you, Lord, for you have rescued me.

*℣ Psalm 30 (29): 2, 4, 5-6, 11-13.*




1. I will extol you, Lord, for you drew me clear, and did not let my enemies rejoice over me.
