 3. All the ends of the earth have seen the salvation by our God.
 4. Sing praise to the Lord with the harp, with the harp and mel - - odious song.

 2. He has remembered his kindness and his faithfulness toward the house of Is - ra - el.
 3. Sing joyfully to the Lord, all you lands; break in - to song, sing praise.
 4. With trumpets and the sound of the horn, sing joyfully be - fore the King, the Lord.
